- (b) To sign, endorse, receive, deposit or issue checks, bonds, notes, stock or other obligations or instruments, and to borrow money and secure the same in any manner.
- (c) To collect, sue for, settle, adjust or compromise any claim for money arising by contract or tort and to execute releases, cancellations or satisfactions.
- (d) To do any other thing or perform any other act, not limited to the foregoing, which I might do in person, it being intended that this shall be a general Power of Attorney.

This Power of Attorney shall remain effective until the same is revoked by written instrument recorded in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Oglethorpe County, Georgia.
